## **Financial Report**

#### Pete Goodson

- Income was \$119,041 vs budget of 103,464. Primary difference being \$12,500 collected for road impact fees
- Collected all undisputed assessments
- Other non-budgeted income:
  - Donations \$4,287 (monies collected from a former member who was offsetting the cost they paid for some road improvements against their annual assessment. Member sold home therefor the remaining balance accrued to the Association)
  - Finance Charges late charges collected
  - Reimbursements Waste Management reimbursed expense for damage done to gate Legal expense recovered legal fees from lien on member
- Expenses were \$139,031 vs budget of \$103,464. Primary difference being additional road repairs resulting from deferred repairs from last year. Residual funds were carried forward.

## Road Maintenance Committee

#### Neil King

- King distributed a written report of work completed last year (attached) Wildflower and Lady Slipper Trail have some ditches in need of repair
- Will continue overlaying to the extent funds are available
- Owners who choose to, may cut back trees, branches, etc. that are causing a hazard within the 60 foot road right-of-ways. Doing so however is at their own risk
- No plan yet for continued road maintenance. Will revisit after winter season.
